	* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)	
	Feminine noun. Connected to the English words "ground", "geometry" and "geology".	
	It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1 εἰρήνῃ ἐν

NLT	"Glory to God in highest heaven, and peace on earth to those with whom God is pleased."	
KJV	Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.	

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
