δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. οὐκ ἔστινρlugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigεἰμί

greek

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. νεκρῶν ἀλλὰ ζώντων· πάντες plugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigπᾶς

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of  $\pi \tilde{\alpha} \zeta$  depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 γὰρ αὐτῷpluginautotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigαὐτός

Meaning

\* He, she, it \* Himself, herself, itself \* Same

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ζῶσιν.

ESV Now he is not God of the dead, but of the living, for all live to him."

NIV He is not the God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive."

NLT So he is the God of the living, not the dead, for they are all alive to him."

KJV For he is not a God of the dead, but of the living: for all live unto him.
