Preposition that relates to movement through space, time, means or cause - it's a preposition of movement and mediation.

When used with the genitive case, διὰ emphasizes the means or channel by which something happens. John 1:3 Matthew 24:12 John 1:32 Timothy 2:10 Romans 5:1 John 1:17 [οὗ](#)[plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁς, ἡ, ὃ](#)

Meaning:

The relative pronoun that connects a relative clause to a main clause, referring back to a noun or pronoun (called the antecedent).

It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning [παραδίδοται](#)).

ESV	For the Son of Man goes as it has been determined, but woe to that man by whom he is betrayed!"
NIV	The Son of Man will go as it has been decreed, but woe to that man who betrays him."
NLT	For it has been determined that the Son of Man must die. But what sorrow awaits the one who betrays him."
KJV	And truly the Son of man goeth, as it was determined: but woe unto that man by whom he is betrayed!

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
