	δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. εἶπαν· κύριε, ἰδοὺ μάχαιραι ὧδε δύο. ὁplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ, ἡ, τό

	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.

ESV	And they said, "Look, Lord, here are two swords." And he said to them, "It is enough."
NIV	The disciples said, "See, Lord, here are two swords. That is enough," he replied.
NLT	"Look, Lord," they replied, "we have two swords among us." "That's enough," he said.
KJV	And they said, Lord, behold, here are two swords. And he said unto them, It is enough.

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
