εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

lt an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. δὲplugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bigδέ

δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. καὶρlugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί

οὖτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19

ESV	There was also an inscription over him, "This is the King of the Jews."
NIV	There was a written notice above him, which read: sc THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.
NLT	A sign was fastened to the cross above him with these words: "This is the King of the Jews."
KJV	And a superscription also was written over him in letters of Greek, and Latin, and Hebrew, THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.
