	* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same
	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)	
ἔφαγεν.	
ESV	and he took it and ate before them.
NIV	and he took it and ate it in their presence.
NLT	and he ate it as they watched.
KJV	And he took it, and did eat before them.

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
