Usage in the New Testament

The sense of $\pi \tilde{\alpha} \zeta$ depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ἠκολούθησαν αὐτῷ.plugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigαὐτός

* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)

ESV	And when they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed him.
NIV	Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will catch men." So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.
NLT	And as soon as they landed, they left everything and followed Jesus.
KJV	And when they had brought their ships to land, they forsook all, and followed him.
