	The definite article ἐνοχλούμενοι ἀπὸ πνευμάτων ἀκαθάρτων ἐθεραπεύοντο·
ESV	who came to hear him and to be healed of their diseases. And those who were troubled with unclean spirits were cured.
NIV	who had come to hear him and to be healed of their diseases. Those troubled by evil spirits were cured,
NLT	They had come to hear him and to be healed of their diseases; and Jesus also cast out many evil spirits.
KJV	And they that were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed.

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
