IT is most frequently translated as "and" ἀπὸ τοῦplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article αἶροντος τὰplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article σὰ μὴ ἀπαίτει.
ESV	Give to everyone who begs from you, and from one who takes away your goods do not demand them back.

NLT	Give to anyone who asks; and when things are taken away from you, don't try to get them back.
