	Meaning
	* Not * Nor * Neither * Not even
	A combination of the words οὐ (meaning no) and δέ (meaning however or but). The word οὐδέ adds another negative element to a sentence that already has one. οὐδέ can join words, phrases, or whole clauses. It often functions like English Matthew 6:20John 7:5Romans 3:10 ἐκ βάτου σταφυλὴν τρυγῶσιν.
ESV	for each tree is known by its own fruit. For figs are not gathered from thornbushes, nor are grapes picked from a bramble bush.
NIV	Each tree is recognized by its own fruit. People do not pick figs from thornbushes, or grapes from briars.
NLT	A tree is identified by its fruit. Figs never grow on thornbushes, nor grapes on bramble bushes.
KJV	For every tree is known by his own fruit. For of thorns men do not gather figs, nor of a bramble bush gather they grapes.

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
