	Meaning
	* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same
	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)	εἰδότες ὅτι ἀπέθανεν.
ESV	And they laughed at him, knowing that she was dead.
NIV	They laughed at him, knowing that she was dead.
NLT	But the crowd laughed at him because they all knew she had died.
KJV	And they laughed him to scorn, knowing that she was dead.
