Greek	greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἔχετε πίστιν θεοῦ, greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God
ESV	And Jesus answered them, “Have faith in God.
NIV	“Have faith in God,” Jesus answered.
NLT	Then Jesus said to the disciples, “Have faith in God.
KJV	And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

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
