	<p>προσεύχεσθε δὲ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἵνα μὴ γένηται</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* To Become * To Come into being * Generate * To Happen * Brought to pass</p> <p>Verb.</p> <p>Different from εἶμι (which means “to be” - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event. John 1:14 John 1:3 Matthew 6:10 χειμῶνος</p>

KJV	And pray ye that your flight be not in the winter.
