Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) σταυροῦσιν δύο ληστές, ἕναplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἷς gree Meaning: * One * First * One thing * Alone * Individual * One ma * Someone εἷς is the cardinal number (“one”). Sometimes it functions as a indefinitely pronoun (“someone” or “a certain one”). It agrees in gender, number and case with the noun it modifies. Occurs a little under 350 times in the New Testament.Matthew 8:19John 10:30 ἐκ δεξιῶν καὶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί
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ESV	And with him they crucified two robbers, one on his right and one on his left.
NIV	They crucified two robbers with him, one on his right and one on his left.
NLT	Two revolutionaries were crucified with him, one on his right and one on his left.
KJV	And with him they crucify two thieves; the one on his right hand, and the other on his left.

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
