	δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English.	
	Ἰησοῦς ἀφείξ φωνὴν μεγάλην ἐξέπνευσεν.	
ESV	And Jesus uttered a loud cry and breathed his last.	
NIV	With a loud cry, Jesus breathed his last.	
NLT	Then Jesus uttered another loud cry and breathed his last.	
KJV	And Jesus cried with a loud voice, and gave up the ghost.	

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
