εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example  $\epsilon l\mu l$  is the word for am and l is the word for was, e.g.  $\delta \epsilon$  plugin-autotooltip \_\_default plugin-autotooltip big $\delta \epsilon$

δέ is a conjunction that can mean "but" or "and" or "also" or "moreover". It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. τινες τῶνρlugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigò

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
