This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:16 1 John 5:11 1 Corinthians 15:50 1 John 4:9 1 John 5:1 Matthew 3:17 John 7:26 Luke 22:19 ἀδελφός μου καὶ

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀδελφὴ καὶ

Meaning

* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” μήτηρ ἐστίν.

greek

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g.

ESV	Whoever does the will of God, he is my brother and sister and mother.“
NIV	Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother.“
NLT	Anyone who does God's will is my brother and sister and mother.“
KJV	For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sister, and mother.

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
