Meaning

* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

Masculine noun meaning:

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δέ is a conjunction that can mean “but” or “and” or “also” or “moreover”. It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of [πάς](#) depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

* To Become * To Come into being * Generate * To Happen * Brought to pass

Verb.

Different from [εἶμι](#) (which means “to be” - a state of existence); [γίνομαι](#), instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event.John 1:14John 1:3Matthew 6:10

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
