	Καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἤλθον εἰς τὸ greek
Greek	The definite article πέραν τῆς greek The definite article θαλάσσης εἰς τὴν greek The definite article χώραν τῶν greek The definite article Γερασηνῶν.
ESV	They came to the other side of the sea, to the country of the Gerasenes.
NIV	They went across the lake to the region of the Gerasenes.
NLT	So they arrived at the other side of the lake, in the region of the Gerasenes.
KJV	And they came over unto the other side of the sea, into the country of the Gadarenes.

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
