Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 πάνταplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigπᾶς

* All * Every * The whole

Adjective.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ἐλάλησεν ὁplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ, ἡ, τό

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as
“and” χωρὶς

greek

Meaning:

* Separately * Apart from * Without * Independently of

Adverb or preposition (taking the genitive case) that expressing exclusion or lack of association
between two things. Occurs 41 times in the New Testament.

Biblical Examples John 15:5 Hebrews 9:22 James 2:26 Matthew 13:34 παραβολῆς οὐδὲν ἐλάλει
αὐτοῖς

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
