εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. [ἡ \[plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ, ἡ, τό\]\(#\)](#)

Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. Usage in the New Testament

The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is
countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9 John 3:16 Romans 5:12 Matthew 28:19 Colossians
1:16 Romans 3:23 Romans 3:23 John 3:16 Colossians 1:17 [γένους συναγαγούση](#).

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
