It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ἀποκριθεὶς εἶπεν αὐτοῖς, plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
