	<p>οὕτως οὐκ ἔστιν <span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>εἰμί</p> <p>greek</p> <p>εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</p> <p>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. <span>θέλημα ἔμπροσθεν τοῦ</span> <span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>ὁ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>The definite article <span>πατρὸς ὑμῶν τοῦ</span> <span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>ὁ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>The definite article <span>ἐν</span> <span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>ἐν</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Preposition meaning “in”. <span>οὐρανοῖς</span> <span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>οὐρανός</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>Greek * The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens</p> <p>278 occurrences in the New Testament.</p> <p>Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 <span>ἵνα ἀπόληται ἐν τῶν</span> <span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>ὁ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>The definite article <span>μικρῶν τούτων</span>. <span>plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big</span>οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Meaning:</p> <p>* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it</p> <p>Demonstrative pronoun.</p> <p>οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19</p>
ESV	So it is not the will of my Father who is in heaven that one of these little ones should perish.
NIV	In the same way your Father in heaven is not willing that any of these little ones should be lost.

NLT	In the same way, it is not my heavenly Father's will that even one of these little ones should perish.
KJV	Even so it is not the will of your Father which is in heaven, that one of these little ones should perish.
