The definite article παιδίον τοῦτο, plugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigούτος / αύτη / τοῦτο

Meaning:

* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 οὗτόςplugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigοὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο

Greek

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ὁπλιν-αὐτοτοῦλιπ default plugin-autotooltip bigὁ

Preposition meaning “in”. $\tau\eta$ plugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigo

The definite article βασιλεία τῶν

The definite article οὐρανῶν.plugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigοὐρανός

Meaning:

* The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens

278 occurrences in the New Testament.

Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9

ESV	Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.
NIV	Therefore, whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.
NLT	So anyone who becomes as humble as this little child is the greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven.
KJV	Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

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
