Greek	καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐπιθεὶς τὰς greek
	The definite article χείρας αὐτοῖς greek
	Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
	ἐπορεύθη ἐκεῖθεν.
	ESV And he laid his hands on them and went away.
	NIV When he had placed his hands on them, he went on from there.
NLT	And he placed his hands on their heads and blessed them before he left.
KJV	And he laid his hands on them, and departed thence.
