	ὡμοιώθη ἡ greek The definite article βασιλεία τῶν greek The definite article οὐρανῶν οὐρανός Meaning: * The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens 278 occurrences in the New Testament. Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 ἄνθρωπῳ βασιλεῖ, ὅστις ἐποίησεν Meaning: * To do * To make This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship. Verb forms Present tense Person Greek Form γάμους τῷ greek The definite article υἱῷ αὐτοῦ. greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
ESV	"The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son,
NIV	"The kingdom of heaven is like a king who prepared a wedding banquet for his son.
NLT	"The Kingdom of Heaven can be illustrated by the story of a king who prepared a great wedding feast for his son.
KJV	The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son,

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
