It is a word that is used very frequently in the New Testament, and is often unexpressed and not translated in English. ὅλον γέγονενplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigγίνομαι greek Meaning * To Become * To Come into being * Generate * To Happen * Brought to pass Verb. Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἔφυγον.

ESV	But all this has taken place that the Scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled." Then all the disciples left him and fled.
NIV	But this has all taken place that the writings of the prophets might be fulfilled." Then all the disciples deserted him and fled.
NLT	But this is all happening to fulfill the words of the prophets as recorded in the Scriptures." At that point, all the disciples deserted him and fled.
KJV	But all this was done, that the scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled. Then all the disciples forsook him, and fled.

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
