	αὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)

ESV	Then they sat down and kept watch over him there.
NIV	And sitting down, they kept watch over him there.
NLT	Then they sat around and kept guard as he hung there.
KJV	And sitting down they watched him there;
