It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. υἰός. He trusts in God; let God deliver him now, if he desires him. For he said, 'I am the Son of God.'" **ESV** He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, 'I am the Son of God.'" NIV He trusted God, so let God rescue him now if he wants him! For he said, 'I am the Son of God.'" **NLT** He trusted in God; let him deliver him now, if he will have him: for he said, I am the Son of KJV God.
