Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

Adjective.

Usage in the New Testament

Greek The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ἐξουσία ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν

Preposition meaning “in”. οὐρανῶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὐρανός

Meaning:

* The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens

278 occurrences in the New Testament.

Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 καὶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί

Meaning:

* Soil or ground (e.g. Matthew 13:5) * Land (e.g. Luke 4:5) * Country * Earth (e.g. Matthew 5:5)

Feminine noun. Connected to the English words “ground”, “geometry” and “geology”.

It occurs throughout the LXX and the New Testament (approximately 250 times in the New Testament) and its meaning varies subtly on context, for example, in the LXX:Genesis 1:1Genesis 2:7Genesis 12:1

ESV	And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.
NIV	Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.
NLT	Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth.
KJV	And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.
