	Preposition. Occurs 703 times in the New Testament.
	πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again. At its core, it usually describes movement or relationship toward someone or something, whether physical, s... αὐτὸν

	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” πᾶσα

	* All * Every * The whole

	Usage in the New Testament
Greek	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
	With singular countable nouns → “every” John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ἡ
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	The definite article ἡ
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	The definite article περίχωρος τοῦ
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ESV	Then Jerusalem and all Judea and all the region about the Jordan were going out to him,
NIV	People went out to him from Jerusalem and all Judea and the whole region of the Jordan.
NLT	People from Jerusalem and from all of Judea and all over the Jordan Valley went out to see and hear John.
KJV	Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan,

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
