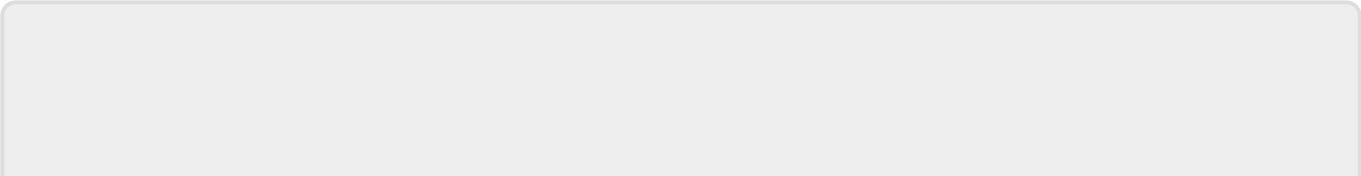

Greek	greek The definite article βασιλεία τῶν greek The definite article οὐρανῶν. οὐρανός Meaning: * The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens 278 occurrences in the New Testament. Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9
ESV	From that time Jesus began to preach, saying, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”
NIV	From that time on Jesus began to preach, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near.”
NLT	From then on Jesus began to preach, “Repent of your sins and turn to God, for the Kingdom of Heaven is near. ”
KJV	From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

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
