	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” εἶπεν αὐτῷ , αὐτός
	greek
	Meaning
	* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same
	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
	Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ταῦτά οὗτος / αὕτη / τοῦτο

	Meaning:
	* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it
	Demonstrative pronoun.
	οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 σοὶ πάντα πᾶς

	Meaning
	* All * Every * The whole
	Adjective.
Greek	Usage in the New Testament
	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
	With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 δώσω ἕαν πεσὼν προσκυνήσῃς μοι.
	ESV
	And he said to him, “All these I will give you, if you will fall down and worship me.”
	NIV
	“All this I will give you,” he said, “if you will bow down and worship me.”

NLT	"I will give it all to you," he said, "if you will kneel down and worship me."
KJV	And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me.

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
