	χαίρετε καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἀγαλλιᾶσθε, ὅτι ὁ greek The definite article μισθὸς ὑμῶν πολὺς ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. τοῖς greek Greek The definite article οὐρανοῖς· Meaning: * The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens 278 occurrences in the New Testament. Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 οὕτως γὰρ ἐδίωξαν τοὺς greek The definite article προφήτας τοὺς greek The definite article πρὸ ὑμῶν.
