IT is most frequently translated as “and” δοξάσωσιν τὸν Greek greek The definite article πατέρα ὑμῶν τὸν greek The definite article ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. τοῖς greek The definite article οὐρανοῖς. Meaning: * The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens 278 occurrences in the New Testament. Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9
ESV	In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

NIV	In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.
NLT	In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father.
KJV	Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

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
