Greek	ὅπως ἥplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek
	The definite article σοῦ ἐλεημοσύνη ἥplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek
	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigέν greek
	Preposition meaning “in”. τῷplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek
	The definite article κρυπτῷ, καὶplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί greek
	Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So
	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ὁplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek
	The definite article πατήρ σου ὁplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek
	The definite article βλέπων ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigέν greek
	Preposition meaning “in”. τῷplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ greek
	The definite article κρυπτῷ ἀποδώσει σοι.
ESV	so that your giving may be in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.
NIV	so that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.
NLT	Give your gifts in private, and your Father, who sees everything, will reward you.
KJV	That thine alms may be in secret: and thy Father which seeth in secret himself shall reward thee openly.

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
