	εἰ οὖν ὑμεῖς πονηροὶ ὄντες plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. οἶδατε δόματα ἀγαθὰ διδόναι τοῖς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek The definite article τέκνοις ὑμῶν, πόσω μᾶλλον ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article πατὴρ ὑμῶν ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. τοῖς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ Greek greek The definite article οὐρανοῖς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὐρανός Meaning: * The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens 278 occurrences in the New Testament. Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 δώσει ἀγαθὰ τοῖς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ greek The definite article αἰτοῦσιν αὐτόν. plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English)
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ESV	If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!
NIV	If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!
NLT	So if you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give good gifts to those who ask him.
KJV	If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?

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
