εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. οἶδατε δόματα ἀγαθὰ διδόναι τοῖς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

The definite article τέκνοις ὑμῶν, πόσω μᾶλλον ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

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The definite article πατὴρ ὑμῶν ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

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The definite article ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν

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Preposition meaning “in”. τοῖς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

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The definite article οὐρανοῖς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigοὐρανός

Meaning:

* The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens

278 occurrences in the New Testament.

Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 δώσει ἀγαθὰ τοῖς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ
