	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἰδὼν ὁ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

	The definite article Ἰησοῦς τὰς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ

	The definite article ἐνθυμήσεις αὐτῶν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός

	Meaning
	* He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same
	Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.

NIV	The definite article καρδίαις ὑμῶν;

	Knowing their thoughts, Jesus said, “Why do you entertain evil thoughts in your hearts?
	Jesus knew what they were thinking, so he asked them, “Why do you have such evil thoughts in your hearts?
