Hebrew	hebrew Meaning * Midst * Among * Within * Inwardly * The centre, whether literal, figurative or adverbial Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament. From the root קרב, meaning “to come near, approach.” So קרב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalm 103:1 וְהִשְׁמַדְתִּי עֲרִיד
ESV	and I will cut off your carved images and your pillars from among you, and you shall bow down no more to the work of your hands;
NIV	I will destroy your carved images and your sacred stones from among you; you will no longer bow down to the work of your hands.
NLT	I will destroy all your idols and sacred pillars, so you will never again worship the work of your own hands.
