	The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.
	This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.
	* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 קָרַב יַעֲקֹב בְּגוֹיִם בְּקָרֵב שְׂאֵלִית יֵעָלֶה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big קָרַב

	Meaning
	* Midst * Among * Within * Inwardly * The centre, whether literal, figurative or adverbial
	Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament.
	From the root קרב, meaning “to come near, approach.” So קָרַב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalm 103:1 רְבִים כְּאֶרֶץ בְּהֶמְנוֹת לֵעָר כְּכַפִּיר בְּעֵדְרֵי צֶאֱן אֲשֶׁר אִם עֶבֶר וְרִמָּס וְטָרֵף וְאִין מִצִּיל
ESV	Then the remnant of Jacob shall be in the midst of many peoples like dew from the LORD, like showers on the grass, which delay not for a man nor wait for the children of man.
NIV	The remnant of Jacob will be in the midst of many peoples like dew from the LORD, like showers on the grass, which do not wait for man or linger for mankind.
NLT	Then the remnant left in Israel will take their place among the nations. They will be like dew sent by the LORD or like rain falling on the grass, which no one can hold back and no one can restrain.

	εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
