| Hebrew | <div>It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.</div> <div>First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 יהוה מן מקרבך</div> <div>יהוה</div> <div>hebrew</div> <div>Meaning</div> <div>* Midst * Among * Within * Inwardly * The centre, whether literal, figurative or adverbial</div> <div>Masculine noun. Occurs over 250 times in the Old Testament.</div> <div>From the root קרב, meaning “to come near, approach.” So קרב is a noun form built from the verb Exodus 17:7Psalm 103:1 יהאבדתי מן קרבתך</div> |
