Hebrew	<p>הָיָה גם את תִּשְׁכָּרוּ תִּהְיֶה הָיָה hebrew</p> <p>The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.</p> <p>This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.</p> <p>* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 נָעַלְמָה גַּם אֶת תְּבַקְשִׁי מֵעוֹן מֵאוֹיֵב</p>
ESV	You also will be drunken; you will go into hiding; you will seek a refuge from the enemy.
NIV	You too will become drunk; you will go into hiding and seek refuge from the enemy.
NLT	And you, Nineveh, will also stagger like a drunkard. You will hide for fear of the attacking enemy.
LXX	<p>καὶ καὶ greek</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So</p> <p>Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” σὺ μεθυσθήσῃ καὶ καὶ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So</p> <p>Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” εἶμι</p> <p>greek</p> <p>εἶμι is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).</p> <p>It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμι is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ὑπερεωραμένη καὶ καὶ</p> <p>greek</p> <p>Meaning</p> <p>* And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So</p> <p>Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” σὺ ζητήσεις σεαυτῇ στάσις ἐξ ἐχθρῶν</p>
