Hebrew	שָׁמַיִם hebrew Meanings: * Heaven or heavens * Sky * Compass Masculine noun. The word is dual in form (ending in -ים) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14 states that Genesis 1:20Psalm 115:3 יֵלֶק פֶּשֶׁט וְיִעָף
ESV	You increased your merchants more than the stars of the heavens. The locust spreads its wings and flies away.
NIV	You have increased the number of your merchants till they are more than the stars of the sky, but like locusts they strip the land and then fly away.
NLT	Your merchants have multiplied until they outnumber the stars. But like a swarm of locusts, they strip the land and fly away.
LXX	ἐπλήθυνας τὰς greek The definite article ἐμπορίας σου ὑπὲρ τὰ greek The definite article ἄστρα τοῦ greek The definite article οὐρανοῦ Meaning: * The sky * Air * Heaven or heavens 278 occurrences in the New Testament. Οὐρανός is used in Scripture to describe the sky and universe (that is, the visible expanse above the earth) as well as the transcendent realm where God is present. For example, in Matthew 6:26Matthew 24:29Matthew 6:9 βροῦχος ὥρμησεν καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐξεπετάσθη
