

Nehemiah 1:8

Hebrew	אתָּplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The Hebrew אתָּ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by (הַדָּבָר אֲשֶׁר צִוִּיתָ אֶת) plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew

LXX	μνήσθητι δὴ τὸν greek The definite article λόγον Meaning * A word or words * Statement * Message * Speech * Account * Used in John to mean God the Son Masculine noun. Related to the verb λέγω. λόγος in Greek Thought Before the New Testament, λόγος already had deep philosophical use. In Greek philosophy, λόγος was the rational principle that ordered the universe, the divine reason that structured all things. In Heraclitus, λόγος referred to the unifying rational principle behind the constant change in the world.... ὃν ἐνετείλω τῷ greek The definite article Μωυσῆ παιδί σου λέγων ὑμεῖς ἐὰν ἀσυνθετήσητε ἐγὼ διασκορπιῶ ὑμᾶς ἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. τοῖς greek The definite article λαοῖς
