NLT	I slipped out during the night, taking only a few others with me. I had not told anyone about the plans God had put in my heart for Jerusalem. We took no pack animals with us except the donkey I was riding.

IT is most frequently translated as “and” κτῆνος οὐκ ἔστινplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
