	קִים־פָּנִי hebrew Meaning: * Face * Presence * Front or surface
Hebrew	פָּנִי הַתֵּימָן וְאֵל Noun, Masculine. Although it looks plural in form (ending in -ים), it is almost always used as a singular in meaning - a type of plural of intensity or plural of form common in Hebrew for body parts that come in pairs or have multiple aspects. פָּנִי הַתֵּימָן וְאֵל הַיָּמִין hebrew The word הָיָה means "to exist" or "to be" or "to become" or "to come into being" and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:11Isaiah 2:2 שָׁמַר בַּחֲסֹת יְרוּשָׁלַם אֲשֶׁר הִסְמְרוּצִים הָיָה פְּרוּצִים וְשַׁעֲרֶיהָ אֲכָלוּ בָאֵשׁ
ESV	I went out by night by the Valley Gate to the Dragon Spring and to the Dung Gate, and I inspected the walls of Jerusalem that were broken down and its gates that had been destroyed by fire.
NIV	By night I went out through the Valley Gate toward the Jackal Well and the Dung Gate, examining the walls of Jerusalem, which had been broken down, and its gates, which had been destroyed by fire.
NLT	After dark I went out through the Valley Gate, past the Jackal's Well, and over to the Dung Gate to inspect the broken walls and burned gates.
