In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. NLT	all the people assembled with a unified purpose at the square just inside the Water Gate. They asked Ezra the scribe to bring out the Book of the Law of Moses, which the LORD had given for Israel to obey.
