Hebrew	The word הִיְהִי means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 וַיִּבְרָא אֱלֹהִים אֶת הַשָּׁמַיִם וְאֶת הָאָרֶץ
ESV	And Ezra opened the book in the sight of all the people, for he was above all the people, and as he opened it all the people stood.
NIV	Ezra opened the book. All the people could see him because he was standing above them; and as he opened it, the people all stood up.
NLT	Ezra stood on the platform in full view of all the people. When they saw him open the book, they all rose to their feet.
