	יהוה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigיהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

ESV	You are the LORD, the God who chose Abram and brought him out of Ur of the Chaldeans and gave him the name Abraham.
NIV	“You are the LORD God, who chose Abram and brought him out of Ur of the Chaldeans and named him Abraham.
NLT	“You are the LORD God, who chose Abram and brought him from Ur of the Chaldeans and renamed him Abraham.

	οὐ εἶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἶμι greek εἶμι is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
